

## SOCIAL STUDIES STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOME AND ASSESSMENT TASK WITH RUBRIC

**SLO#1:** Social Studies students demonstrate the ability to appraise events and happenings in the local, regional, national, and global community.

**SLO Assessment Activity:** The students will analyze issues, events and challenges that have occurred recently in the local, regional, national and global community by participating in discussions of the incidents with other individuals. Students will be observed by faculty facilitator and assessed according to the following rubric.

2-Acceptable	Shows faulty comprehension of individuals, events, and issues  Demonstrates mistaken responses to questions regarding social studies contents	Explores, explains, and justifies with some errors  Makes few connections to individuals, events, issues	Presents information with three or four errors  Unsatisfactorily answers questions	Explains ideas with fairly clear details  Uses little social studies terminology
1-Unsatisfactory	Shows no comprehension of the impact of individuals, events, and issues  Demonstrates inappropriate reactions to social studies content	Explores, explains, and justifies inappropriately  Makes no, or inappropriate, connections to individuals, events, or issues	Presents information incorrectly  Improperly names key ideas	Does not clearly explain ideas with effective details  Uses no or incorrect social studies terminology

**SCORING:** Pre and Post Assessments are administered. Emeritus Social Studies Students meet the SLO standard if they show progress on post test.

**SCORING Example for ASE:** Students must make an average score of at least three (3) **AND** score NO lower than a two (2) in any performance area to meet the SLO Standard.
